The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 71 dated 23.04.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 382/447/511/323/506/34/120-B of IPC and under Sections 25/27/54 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Civil lines, Bathinda alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-2*).

The report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, FIR No. 71 dated 23.04.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 382/447/511/323/506/34/120-B of IPC under Sections 25/27/54 of the Arms

Act, at Police Station Civil lines, Bathinda stand quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-2*).

In view of the above, the petition is allowed.
