The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 25.09.2015, under Sections 419/420/465/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station NRI Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

A further submission is made that the petitioner would be ready and willing to surrender and if thereafter an application is filed seeking the benefit of regular bail, such application be directed to be decided immediately.

As per submission made by counsel, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders before the Investigating Agency/Illaq Magistrate within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking benefit of bail such application would be dealt with strictly on merits and every endeavor would be made to expedite the disposal of the same.
