This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 directing them not to harass or humiliate the petitioners by repeatedly calling them to the police station and further not to falsely implicate them in any false case.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot to look into the grievances

unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated April 30, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
