For having been found in possession of 700 tablets of Microlit, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 24.8.2015. The total weight of the tablets recovered from the petitioner is approximately 44 grams where as 50 grams is described as commercial quantity of diphenoxylate hydrochloride.

No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody, he can be granted the concession of bail. The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not commit any similar offence of which he is accused of during the entire period of the trial.
