Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to accused petitioner-Raman Kumar @ Lamba in case FIR No.25 dated 13.2.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 427, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 Indian Penal Code (later on Sections 326/307 IPC added) registered with Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.

Over a dispute arising on account of kite flying between two groups of boys, accused party consisting of 10 persons fully armed including the present petitioner are alleged to have gone to the house of complainant-Vinay Kumar at around 9 pm on 12.2.2016 and launched an attack.

Role attributed to the petitioner is of giving kick and fist blows

to the complainant.

It is contended that the petitioner has been roped in merely because he was present at the initial time of dispute in the morning and even otherwise has been attributed only fist blows. Further submits that main accused have already been arrested and recovery of weapons effected.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated in the same.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Charanjit Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 06th of May, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
