JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.107 dated 10.09.2014, under Sections 22/61/85 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered with Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, recovery of 100 grams of intoxicating powder was made from the conscious possession of the petitioner, which quantity concededly is 'commercial in nature'.

The petitioner is stated to be granted interim bail by the trial Court, vide order dated 18.11.2014 (**Annexure P-2**) due to non-receipt of the FSL report. After the receipt of FSL report, the seized contraband is found containing psychotropic substance of commercial quantity.

Keeping in view the seized contraband being commercial in nature, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
