Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.279 dated 26.12.2015, under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, Registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 60 kgs. of poppy husk.

The same would be construed as marginally over and above the commercial quantity.

The petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Without making any observations on merits, the petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.
