Petitioner had previously preferred CRM No.M-26650 of 2015 seeking benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.208 dated 01.11.2012, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Such petition was disposed of by a coordinate Bench of this Court in the light of order dated 31.08.2015 which reads as follows:-

“Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.208 dated 01.11.2012, under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Heard.

Petitioner was found in possession of 600 grams of Dextropropoxyphene. Thus, petitioner was found in possession of commercial quantity of the

contraband.

Hence, no ground for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

Since the petitioner is in custody since 01.11.2012, trial Court is directed to dispose of the trial expeditiously.”

Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that out of 07 prosecution witnesses cited, 05 have been examined till date and the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 24.05.2016.

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial positively within a period of four months from today.
