The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 18, dated 22.01.2016, registered under Section 336 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar City, and all the subsequent proceedings taken in pursuance thereof, on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2, Gurmukh Singh, alleging that the petitioners along with others had come to the house of the complainant as there was a marriage function going on. Petitioner No.1 fired three shots from his pistol in the air, as a result of which the complainant and his family members rushed inside the house to save their lives.

The matter is stated to have been compromised.

The petition is disposed of with a direction that the complainant or any other affected person may get their supplementary statements recorded by approaching the investigating officer within a period of one month. On the basis of the supplementary statements/statements furnished voluntarily by the witnesses, it will be open to the investigating officer to file cancellation report before the Illaqa Magistrate, which may be accepted by the Court, in case no objection is offered by the complainant.
