Prayer is for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.224 dated 28.10.2015, under Sections 21, 61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur.

There is a recovery of 210 grams of intoxicating powder and 10 grams of *Heroin* from the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the petitioner has already been released on default bail by the trial Court in the light of the provisions of Section 167(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Surender Singh, acknowledges the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
