JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Manjit Kaur Bains-petitioner seeking setting aside of order dated November 2, 2015, January 30, 2016 and February 01, 2016 whereby the petitioner has been allowed to visit abroad, for six months, subject to her furnishing indemnity bond of ₹7,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount and subject to the following conditions:-

“1. That in absence of the applicant/accused, her counsel will appear on her behalf on each and every date of hearing;

2. That the applicant-accused will not dispute her identity and will not raise any objection, in case, evidence of the prosecution is recorded in her

absence.”

2. This Court has gone through the impugned orders and the same are perfectly justified and there is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned orders. As such, they do not call for any interference by this Court.

3. Dismissed.
