Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in case F.I.R. No.140 dated 6.8.2014 under sections 420, 406 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Model Town, Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Allegations in brief leveled by the complainant are that a sum of Rs.11,50,000/- has been misappropriated by the present petitioner as also his wife namely Jyoti Sharma on the pretext of sending the complainant abroad.

During the course of arguments, it has been conceded that wife of the petitioner namely Jyoti Sharma was arrested and after completion of investigation even challan under Section 173 Cr.P.C stands presented qua her.

The present petitioner having evaded the process of law already stands declared a Proclaimed Offender vide order dated 19.1.2015.

Under such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to extend the concession of pre-arrest bail in favour of the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
