Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in case F.I.R. No.319 dated 3.10.2015 under sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Tripuri Town, Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Suffice it to notice the allegations against all the accused including the present petitioner are in the nature of having cheated the complainant party to the tune of Rs.7 crores approximately and having received such amount on different dates on the pretext of purchasing land in the name of the complainant Jagdeep Singh and his mother Nasib Kaur and thereafter having handed over forged and fabricated sale deeds.

The specific allegation in so far as the present petitioner is concerned is that he had received Rs.50 lacs as earnest money from complainant Jagdeep Singh vide agreement to sell dated 27.4.2012 in respect of land measuring 46 kanals 6 marlas of which he was not even the owner.

Allegations are not only specific but are very serious in nature.

It would be a case which may necessitate custodial interrogation of the petitioner to unveil the truth. This Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 17.11.2015, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala declining concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
