JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused in case FIR No.691 dated 02.09.2015, under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station City Jind, District Jind (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the main accused/non-applicant-Ramesh Parjapati, posing as General Manager of BSNL and by preparing false document induced the complainant to part with Rs.7 Lacs as security for launching a free medical service. Thus, the complainant-Dr. Suresh Jain is alleged to have been cheated of that amount.

The role of the petitioner is collection of a sum of Rs.7 Lacs from the complainant.

It is contended that the main accused Ramesh Parjapati has since been released on bail, while the petitioner is stated to be in custody since 25.09.2015 and challan is stated to have been presented.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by S.I. Kulwant Singh, does not refute the contention that the main accused Ramesh Parjapati was granted default bail under Section 167(2)(a) Cr.P.C. and the fact that the case is at the stage of framing of charge.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the facts as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
