By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.123, dated 30.07.2015, registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 420 IPC and Sections 18, 19 and 20 of Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act, 1994 (for short 'the Act'), at Police Station Division No.7, Jullunder, District Jalandhar City.

It is contended that the petitioner is an innocent lady. She has been falsely roped being the wife of an accused in the instant case, namely Harwinder Singh, who has been granted the concession

of regular bail by the trial Court, vide order dated 19.10.2015. In pursuance of the order dated 15.01.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel submits that though the petitioner has joined investigation, however, she is also involved in the instant case.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record minutely.

The petitioner is the wife of co-accused Harwinder Singh and he used to give money to her and they bought a plot with such earnings. The petitioner was much aware of the act being done by his husband. Therefore, taking into consideration the gravity and seriousness of the offence, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail.

Dismissed.
