FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 26.05.2016 sent by learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Fazilka has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Manoj Kumar Fulwaria as well as of complainant Parveen Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the petitioner is a juvenile and the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between

them and in view of law laid down in *Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543* and *Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052*, FIR No.60 dated 12.03.2016 under Sections 153-A IPC and Sections 66,66A of Information Technology Act, 2000 Police Station, City-I Abohar , and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.

Petition stands disposed off.
