Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Deepali Bassi in case FIR No.72 dated 14.07.2013 for the offences punishable under Sections 364-A, 307, 323, 324, 171, 148, 149, 120-B, 506, 420, 467, 468, 471, 201 of the Indian Penal Code; Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana.

The son-Munish Kumar of the complainant-Harminder Pal and his driver-Him Lal were travelling in a BMW Car from the factory to his house in Ludhiana. They were followed by two co-accused and upon interception of the Car, two were kidnapped and kept in a Farm House for a ransom of Rs.5 crores. Both Munish Kumar and Him Lal were released on payment of such ransom.

The role of the petitioner/accused is that of co-conspirator, who had provided some support at the Farm House where she concededly visited twice. There are some SMS messages with one of the main accused. The first bail application of the petitioner/accused has been dismissed by this Court

in detail, vide order dated 25.04.2014.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 16.07.2013.

After arguing for sometime, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
