The petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.191 dated 26.09.2015 registered under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned State counsel upon intrusions from the IO has pointed out that in investigation it has come that the petitioner's bank account had ₹7,23,000/- and the same was withdrawn by him.

The present matter relates to big fraud, forgery and cheating related to the poor and gullible investors who had parted with their money and have lost their money. The petitioner claims to be manager of such firm. There is also no explanation as to the huge amount of ₹7,23,000/-, prima facie, clearly made the case against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter the concession of anticipatory bail cannot be made available to such petitioner. Hence, interim order dated 25.05.2016 is vacated and the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
