FIR in the present case was registered at the instance of Inspector Inderjit Singh on the basis of a secret information that he along with others was a member of gang and indulged in smuggling across the border. As the petitioner was named in the secret information, he was arrested in the present case, while in custody, in another case after obtaining production warrants from the Court.

With the assistance of learned State counsel, I have gone through the police file. Though the petitioner is involved in eight other cases but so far as the present case is concerned, no recovery has been effected from the petitioner, as such, he can be granted the concession of bail in the present case.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. He be released, if not required to be detained, in any other criminal case pending against him.
