DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case, FIR No.46 dated 22.09.2015 registered under Sections 304-B/34 IPC at Police Station Tibbar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was found innocent during investigation. He further submits that the petitioner is still ready to join investigation and no custodial interrogation is required. Learned counsel also submits that the trial Court has taken cognizance against the petitioner under Section 193 Cr.P.C, whereas, there are only general allegations and no specific allegation of demand of dowry or harassment thereof before death has been attributed to the present petitioner.

Admittedly, the petitioner has not approached before the trial Court for anticipatory bail and has straightway filed the present petition before this Court. Even the summoning order has not been challenged by her so far. Only on the ground that the petitioner is ready to join investigation, the petitioner is not entitled for grant of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, in case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and moves an application for bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same within a period of one week thereafter.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.
