Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that the petitioner and his co-accused were making plan to commit dacoity, armed with deadly weapons and that they indulged in the supply of intoxicating substances to different cities of Punjab after getting the same from Pakistan.

A raid having been conducted after registration of the FIR, four co-accused of the petitioner had been apprehended at the spot. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he allegedly was involved on the basis of confessional statement of his co-accused and his confessional statement in another case while in custody. The petitioner has been in custody with effect from July 12, 2015

Co-accused of the petitioner arrested from the spot, have been granted the concession of regular bail. Since the petitioner was not arrested from the spot his culpability will certainly be a debatable issue during the course of trial.

Petitioner in these circumstance can be granted concession of regular bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
