Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C. by Sarad Kumar Dobey, seeking bail in case FIR No.46, dated 11.04.2015, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana, during the pendency of trial.

2. Concededly, the chemical examiner report from Forensic Science Laboratory has not been received so far and as per the version of learned State counsel, some more time is likely to take for the receipt of the aforesaid report.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the ld. trial court to release the petitioner on interim bail till the receipt of the chemical examiner report. Further, the investigating officer is also directed to inform the petitioner as and when report is received and the interim order for bail shall enure for a period of 10 days after he was served with the report of the chemical examiner to approach the competent court of jurisdiction.
