**JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)**

This is a petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Kamlesh, feeling apprehension of her arrest, in case FIR No.31 dated 25.02.2016, under Sections 380, 389 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion by this Court on May 09, 2016, the following order was passed:-

*“Petitioner is a lady who apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Om Parkash a 70 years old retired government employee alleging that the petitioner had started living with him as a companion after the death of his wife. She is alleged to have in connivance with one Mohit has extorted sum of Rs.3 lacs from him and committed theft in the house.*

*Counsel for the petitioner relies upon few photographs indicating that the complainant had married the petitioner in the month of March 2008 and that he wants to evade his obligations by levelling false allegations.*

*Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 2.8.2016.*

*Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on or before 21.5.2016. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”.*

On instructions from HC Satish Kumar, learned State counsel submits that petitioner has already joined the investigation in compliance of the order dated May 09, 2016 and is no more required for further interrogation.

Taking into consideration all the above referred aspects of the case, order dated May 09, 2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
