This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.16 dated 16.2.2016 under sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C registered at Police Station, Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R came to be registered on the statement of Vinod Bassi. Allegations were primarily targeted against Mohan Singh Pahalwan, who is stated to have taken a loan of Rs.6 lacs from the complainant and towards discharge of such financial obligation had offered to get a sale deed of a plot measuring 100 sq. yards executed in favour of the complainant. Further allegations are that on 16.2.2016 when Mohan Singh, main accused called the complainant in the office of Sub Registrar (West), Ludhiana, the present petitioner namely Paramjit Singh made an attempt to impersonate the real owner i.e. Anil Puri and on the asking of Mohan Singh.

Petitioner was arrested on 16.2.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan stands

presented on 15.4.2016.

Offences are triable by the court of a Magistrate.

It is not the case made out on behalf of the State or by counsel for the complainant that the petitioner, if, granted benefit of bail would be in a position to threaten or intimidate the witnesses and as such, hamper the course of a free and fair trial.

Without making any observations on merits and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Petition disposed of.
