No one is present on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has produced statements of petitioners as well as respondents No.4 to 6 which are taken on record. A perusal of statements made by petitioners shows that they do not have any threat/danger to their lives and liberty. Similarly respondents No.4 to 6 have stated that they do not have any objection to the marriage of the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
