Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.117 dated 25.11.2013, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 354, 506, 34 IPC.

At the very outset, learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 15.06.2016. She further states that the compromise has been effected between the parties.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 09.05.2016, passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
