This is an application for impleadment of applicant as respondent No.4 in the array of parties. For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed. Amended memo of parties be taken on record.

CRM-M-15001 of 2014

Prayer of the petitioner is for registration of FIR on the basis of complaint (Annexure P/4). Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer on the ground that earlier FIR was lodged on the same ground. However, accused were acquitted. Instant complaint has also been examined by the concerned official. No substance has been found in the allegations levelled by the petitioner.

Under the circumstances, no case for interference in the inherent jurisdiction is made out.

Dismissed.
