This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.104 dated

Dhinga, District Kapurthala.

Even though the main dispute still lingers but for the limited purpose of bail an agreement has been arrived at between the learned counsel on instructions from their clients who are present in Court. It has been agreed that in case the petitioner deposits an amount of Rs.5 lakhs in the shape of Fixed Deposit in the name of the concerned Court (to be handed over to the party found entitled thereto at the conclusion) he would be entitled to anticipatory bail.

In the circumstances, it is made clear that in case the petitioner makes the necessary deposit on or before 23.11.2016 before the trial Court, it shall confirm the interim bail granted by the investigating officer. In case the said amount is not deposited the present petition would be deemed to be dismissed on this ground.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
