Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioners have filed their joint affidavit dated 19.5.2016 to the effect that they do not feel any threat to their lives and need no protection. Besides this, respondents No.4 to 7, who are relatives of the petitioners, have also filed their affidavits dated

23.5.2016 before the police that they will not interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners. The copies of affidavits of the petitioners as well as respondents are taken on record.

In view of the above, no further order is required to pass in the present petition.

However, in case the petitioners still feel any danger to their lives, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur.
