TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA. J (ORAL)

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.100 dated 30.06.2015, under Sections 420/120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

The present petitioner is stated to be of the real brother of Jaswinder Kaur @ Rimpdy. Allegations against the present petitioner are that he in connivance with Jaswinder Kaur and brother-in-law Amrik Singh Rajput @ Lucky i.e. husband of Jaswinder Kaur had in the first instance got an insurance policy of Rs.7 crore and 20 lacs in Canada from Allianz Company Canada and Trans America Insurance and thereafter had lodged a false missing report of Jaswinder Kaur and thereafter identified the dead body of another woman as Jaswinder Kaur so as to gain benefit of the insurance policy.

Petitioner was arrested on 08.07.2015.

Investigation in the case having been completed, challan was presented and even charges have been framed.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Bikram Singh, would apprise the Court that out of 10 prosecution witnesses cited, 03 have been examined. The trial as such would take some time to conclude.

It has gone uncontroverted that the attempt to take advantage of setting up a false insurance claim did not finally fructify as during the course of investigation of such claim, it was found that Jaswinder Kaur co-accused was still alive.

Without making any observations on merit and keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ferozepur.

Disposed of.
