The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 444, dated 21.11.2012, registered under Sections 427, 452 and 506/34 IPC at Police Station Sector – 5, Panchkula, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2, Nidhi, alleging that on 16.04.2012, the petitioners along with 3-4 other persons had attacked the complainant and her family members in their house with *dandas* and *lathies* and caused damage to the house, besides abusing the complainant and her family members.

The parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded.

After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been received that accused Bachan Singh has expired and the matter has been compromised by the complainant party with the remaining accused.

I have gone through the statements of Nidhi and Sunit Joshi, who have admitted that they have compromised the matter with their free will and consent without any threat, coercion or undue influence. The dispute between the neighbours having been settled vide compromise, the FIR can be quashed in view of Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulvinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**, 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052.

The petition is accepted and the aforesaid FIR and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
