The petitioner has filed present petition seeking regular bail in case FIR No.35 dated 10.08.2015 under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur, Punjab.

Copies of the zimni orders and the statement have been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since 20.10.2015 and states that Ramanjit Kaur had committed suicide in her hostel and the petitioner was in Uttar Pradesh and no suicide note was left and only four witnesses have been examined out of 14 witnesses. Counsel refers to the statement made by the father and states that

inmates of the hostel are not allowed to leave the hostel or make any calls and the institution is known for its strictness.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he is ready to submit local surety and abide by any condition.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of bail bonds and local surety to the satisfaction of trial Court.
