The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.51,
dated 29.3.2016, registered under Section 326 of the IPC, at Police
Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has
now been in custody for four months and fifteen days and that there is
delay of 195 days in the registration of the present FIR.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Jaidev

Singh, has vehemently opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner by saying that as a result of the blow of the petitioner, left eye of the complainant-injured was completely damaged.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
