JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C.for grant of regular bail in FIR No.33 dated 19.03.2016 registered under Sections 436, 427 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. No injury has been attributed to the petitioners. The incident is alleged to have taken place on 18.03.2016 at about 9.30 p.m. whereas, the FIR was registered on 19.03.2016 at 11.30 a.m. The petitioners are in custody since 19.03.2016.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application and states that the petitioners are specifically named in the FIR and they had set on fire two bottles of oil and thrown burning bottles inside the shop of the complainant.

Heard.

On a specific query put by the Court, the learned State counsel on instructions, concedes that no photographs of the scene of occurrence were taken by the investigating agency. There is no material on record to

quantify the loss/damage alleged to have been suffered by the complainant.

Keeping in view the fact that the challan already stands presented, out of eight prosecution witnesses, examination-in-chief of only one witness has been recorded so far, therefore, it can safely be inferred that the conclusion of trial will take a long time, so, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioners be admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
