The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.387 dated 05.08.2015 registered under Sections 380, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Sector 34, District Chandigarh.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Perused the interim order dated 10.05.2016 passed by this Court.

The petitioner is a tenant in the house. Learned counsel for the U.T. Chandigarh states that the stolen documents or the instruments namely cheques were not in favour of the petitioner-tenant. The principal accused appears to be one Sahil Sharma, even according to the learned public prosecutor

In view of the above, interim order dated 10.05.2016 is made absolute. The petitioner is directed to re-join the investigation and to cooperate with the Investigating Officer and also give his specimen of signatures and handwriting.
