JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to provide adequate security to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner as well to his family members at the hands of respondents No.6 to 9 and to look into the complaints i.e. Annexures P-1 to P-5.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to get an inquiry conducted into the allegations levelled in the various complaints and to take an appropriate action.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. A.S. Kler, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his various complaints i.e. Annexures P-2 to P-5 and in case some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
