Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.14 dated 09.03.2016, registered under Sections 302, 304-B, 498-A, 307, 148, 149 of IPC, Police Station Mehal Kalan, Distt. Barnala, Punjab.

Learned State counsel submits that the police has not verified residence of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the petitioner has been named in the FIR, but Baljit Kaur-deceased in the suicide note had mentioned that he (Major Singh) was a nice man.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order dated 17.05.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.05.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
