This is the third application for the grant of regular bail.

The allegation against the petitioner is that his car had been used to abduct Ankit who was set on fire for ransom amount of Rs.15 lacs having not been released.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner. 32 witnesses out of 39 witnesses cited by the prosecution already stand examined.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner has been in custody for the last more than four years, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expeditiously dispose of the trial by giving short dates of hearing. In case the trial is not concluded in the month of August, 2016, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail
