This is a petition challenging the order of the Trial Court for further investigation into the case FIR No. 49 dated 08.06.2013 under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC P.S. Sadar Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

As per the allegation, the petitioner was alleged to have beaten his wife to death. On two occasions cancellation report was filed . As per the postmortem report cause of death was liver and kidney disease and she was suffering from superficial injuries which could not lead to the death of

the victim. On both the occasions the Trial Court order for further investigation only on the ground that complainant was not satisfied. Today again learned DAG on instructions from Investigating Officer states that no further material has been found against the petitioner and the police has to file a cancellation report.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of has having become rendered infructuous but the Trial Court is directed that further investigation should be only on some specific ground and not merely because the complainant is not satisfied with the investigation.
