Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.172 dated 24.11.2015, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur, under Sections 364, 452, 342, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. K.B.Raheja, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant and have gone

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through the record.

In pursuance of the order dated 02.06.2016, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. The injuries which are stated to have been caused to the injured, are simple in nature with blunt weapon.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 02.06.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
