This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.123 dated 05.02.2014, registered under Sections 420,406,120-B IPC and u/s 4/5/6 of Chit Fund Act, 1978 and u/s 3 of HPID Act, 2013, at Police Station City Sirsa.

As per the allegations, the petitioner along with co-accused had deputed a number of people for a sum of ₹300 crores.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in other FIRs wherein same allegations were made against the petitioner and by orders Annexures P-1 and P-2, regular bail has been granted to the petitioner in those cases.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Rajpal has accepted this factual assertion.

In order Annexure P-1, the Court had noticed that the petitioner had been director of the Company for a period of three months.

In this view of the matter, since those bail orders have not been challenged and keeping in view the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
