The petitioner seeks quashing of order dated 16.10.2015 (Annexuer P-12) passed by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Gurgaon, whereby the revision of the petitioner against order dated 07.09.2015 (Annexure P-10) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurgaon was dismissed.

Learned Magistrate had dismissed the application of the petitioner filed under Section 311 Cr.P.C. for recalling the complainant for further cross-examination.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have also carefully gone through the case file.

It comes out that a case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 is pending, wherein the complainant was examined. Now the accused wants to recall the

complainant to put some more questions as it is claimed that afterwards, the accused came to know that the postal receipts filed by the complainant are forged. If it is so, the present petitioner can lead the evidence to prove the forgery but no ground to recall the complainant is made out.

Hence, the present petition stands dismissed.
