This is a petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to grant permission to go to USA for a period of six months in case FIR No. 39 dated 09.03.2013 under Section 420 IPC and Section 12-B of Passports Act, 1967, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna.

On instructions from ASI Malkiat Singh, learned State counsel submitted that in addition to instant FIR No. 39 dated 09.03.2016 under Section 420 IPC and Section 12-B of Passports Act, 1967, another FIR bearing No. 154 dated 10.06.2010 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC was also registered at Police Station Sadar

Khanna, which has already been quashed by this Court in *CRM-M No. 32817 of 2013*, captioned as '*Hardeep Singh vs. State of Punjab*'.

Since the allegations in the instant FIR were the same, a cancellation report has already been furnished in the Court of Jurisdictional Magistrate, Khanna.

In view of submission of cancellation report, the instant petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

Since the Jurisdictional Magistrate is already seized of the matter, the said application is disposed of with direction to petitioner to move a fresh application which shall be disposed of by the learned Magistrate within a period of seven days from the date of this instruction.
