The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.189 dated 07.12.2014 registered under Sections 354 and 506 IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of written compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

The parties had appeared before the court below and made statement. The report has been received. Counsel for the complainant points out that though the report is that compromise is voluntary but the complainant had made statement that she was making the statement on the assurance given by the petitioner that he would marry her after the FIR is quashed.
