For having been found in possession of 150 grams of intoxicant powder containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 17.10.2015.

In view of recovery having been effected on the spot from the petitioner at the time of his arrest; the quantity of intoxicating powder recovered from the petitioner being commercial, no ground is made out to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed. However, a direction is issued that the trial Court shall make earnest endeavour to conclude the entire prosecution evidence within a period of next three months. In case, the entire prosecution evidence is not concluded within a period of three months, the petitioner would be entitled to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
