Petitioners seek benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.62 dated 12.09.2015, under Section 395 IPC, registered at Police Station Mansa City-I, District Mansa.

Counsel at the very outset makes a statement that he is not pressing the present petition as regards petitioner No.2, namely, Rajinder Singh @ Raju. Accordingly, the instant petition qua petitioner No.2 stands dismissed as not pressed.

Insofar as petitioners No.1 & 3 are concerned, allegations are that the complainant, Amrik Singh @ Mika was accosted while travelling in a scorpio vehicle on 11.09.2015 and the vehicle was forcibly taken away along with cash and ornaments having a value of Rs.1,85,000/-.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has also been presented. Recovery of approximately Rs.50,000/- cash and certain ornaments has been effected from Rajinder Singh @ Raju.

Petitioner No.1 has been in custody since 06.10.2015 and

petitioner No.3 has been in custody since 14.09.2015.

Without making any observations on merit, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners No.1 and 3 be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
