Present petition has been filed praying for the directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their parents.

Pusuant to the order dated 11.05.2016 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitoners has produced a photocopy of FDR for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1-Jyoti, for a term of three years. The same is taken on record.

At this stage, Mr.Ravinder Singh Dhull, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 to 9 and filed Power of Attorney,

which is taken on record. He submits that that no harm will be caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents, as they do not have any objection to the matrimonial alliance.

Learned counsel for the State has also produced the statements of the both the petitioners to the effect that they are living together and do not required any police protection. The statements of both the petitioners are also taken on record.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach the concerned SSP, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
