For having been found in possession of non-commercial quantity of 500 grams of herion, petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 06.01.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the orders granting bail to co-accused of the petitioner. The petitioner does not deserve parity with the co-accused on the basis of the difference of the quantity. The co-accused have been granted bail mainly on the ground that the recovery effected from them was marginally higher than the commercial quantity prescribed.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the prosecution agency is not able to produce all the witnesses and trial is not concluded within four months after the next date of hearing, the trial Court itself shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
