This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 164 dated 02.04.2016, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6 of Immoral Trafficking Act, Sections 366-A, 372, 506 IPC and Section 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, registered at Police Station, City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Zile Singh, has informed the Court that challan has already been presented against the accused-petitioner n 26.05.2016 and now the trial is fixed for consideration of framing of charges on 13.07.2016.

The role attributed to the petitioner is that she was present in the house and recovery of Rs.500/- was effected from her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the house in

question does not belong to the petitioner, rather it belongs to the other co-accused.

The petitioner is in custody since 02.04.2016.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.
