The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct an impartial, fair and expeditious investigation in case FIR No.39 dated 13.02.2016, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Sangrur.

Further directions are sought to the official respondents to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as also his family members by making averments that they are facing threat and apprehension at the hands of the private respondents.

Without going into the merits of the case and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition by granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.2 i.e. The

Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur as regards his grievance and apprehension.

It is further directed that in case any representation is moved by the petitioner, respondent No.2 would be obligated to consider the same and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
